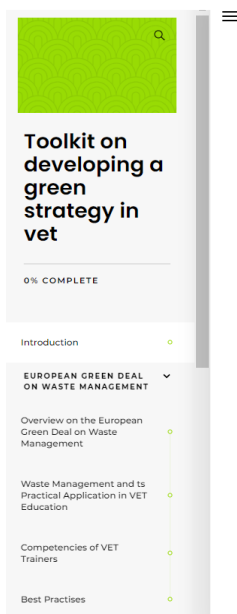

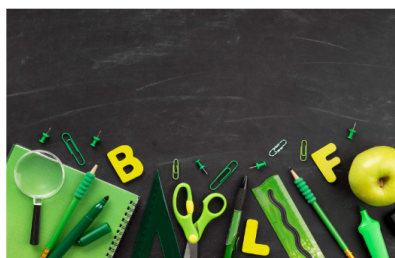

This toolkit is the result of a collaborative effort among partner countries, including Poland, Greece, Cyprus, Portugal, Italy, and Bulgaria, to address the specific needs of Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers in sustainable waste management and the green transition. The development process began with each partner conducting a literature review focused on sustainable waste management strategies and the green transition within the VET sector at both national and European levels. Following this foundational research, comprehensive surveys were conducted in each partner country, involving at least 358 online questionnaires and focus groups with 60 members of the target group.
